list I am writing a function that will output a list in
sorted order. It works fine, however I want to

prepend a string to the output. I am currently stuck on adding the string at the start of the function, so that I can use the print function to add the string, but after I call the function the string is output as part of the original list. E.g. The original list will be sorted in ascending order (with Int.min) and after I call the function output it will then be in the correct order. I want to prepend the string "in ascending order" to the output of the list.

    """This function will return a list in ascending order"""  
    lst = []  
    for x in xs:  
        if compare(x, lst[0]):  
            return 1  
        else:  
            return 0
```
